The Trentham Estate - Fishery Rules 2010

Anglers are asked at all times to behave in a sporting and considerate manner towards their fellow anglers and to be considerate and polite towards Trentham staff and members of the public. The rules listed below are for everybody's benefit and your assistance in enforcing them will be most appreciated.

1. Fishing and car parking at anglers' own risk.
2. No alcohol.
3. No bad language. No heckling other users of the facility.
4. No dogs.
5. Juvenile members need to be accompanied by an adult season ticket holder whether they are day or night fishing.
6. No visitors (Security reserve the right to check all bivvies after site shut down).
7. Any member who aids and abets a non member to fish will have their ticket confiscated.
8. Leave no litter. You are responsible for litter in your swim. Please collect and bag it up and leave at the nearest bin when you leave.
9. Back leads are to be used on all areas where boats are in use.
10. No open fires (including BBQ's)
11. Rods must be attended at all times. No member to leave his/her rods unattended with lines cast in or with baited hooks.
12. Any member who leaves their swim for more than one hour must remove all their belongings. Members are not allowed to reserve swims.
13. A maximum of three rods only to be used.
14. Members must be in possession of the correct amount of current EA license/s. If 3 rods are being used you must have 2 licenses. This will be inspected by the bailiffs.
15. Anglers, fishing for pike, must use 12 lb minimum breaking strain line and a minimum of 20 lb trace wire.
16. Anglers must use line of 8 lb minimum breaking strain when fishing for specimen carp. Please note - if the lead is over 3oz or more, a shock leader must be used.
17. No braided fishing line (may be used on a marker rod).
18. Barbless hooks only.
19. Unhooking mats must be used at all times.
20. No bait boats to be used. No boats of any kind to be used including inflatable's. No swimming and no wading above thigh depth.
21. Fish only to be sacked while preparing photographic equipment-max 10mins. If for any reason a fish needs to be retained for longer than 10mins you must inform a bailiff or security to witness safe return of the fish. Fish must not be kept out of water for photographic purposes for longer than is absolutely necessary. They must then be released to the water and not returned to a keep net or sack.
22. All nuts are banned.
23. No bloodworm or joker permitted.
24. No keep nets to be used.
25. No fishing within 10 yards of another angler without mutual consent.
26. No radios or tape players except personal stereo type equipment.
27. Cars may only be parked on the recognized car-parks on the retail area and southern entrance (Monkey Park). Overnight parking at Monkey Park by parking permit only. Charge applies.
28. Vehicles must not move through the site between the hours of 10pm and 8am.
29. Trentham Fishery will be closed on the 25th&26th December for the full 48hrs.
30. Application forms for season tickets are available from Trentham Management Suite. Tickets will be valid from the 1st of each month for 12 months.
31. Wildlife and wildfowl must not be interfered with or disturbed in any way and members must not cut or remove trees, bushes.
32. Please respect local residents. No parking at Strongford, by the houses by Strongford Garage.
33. To ensure the security of the site and fish stock members agree that bags and vehicles may be checked and searched at any time by the bailiffs or Security

Infringement of the rules may result in a warning and then possible exclusion from the site. Trentham reserve the right to refuse admission to anyone deemed to be acting in an inappropriate manner on the site.
